- JURISDICTION: The Show will be held under the licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. as in force on the 16th June 2019
- **2) REGISTRATION etc.** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
- 3) VENUE: The Show will be held at the National Show Centre, Cloghran, Co. Dublin. Car Park €5.00.pre paid or €5 on the day of the Show Catalogue €5.00.pre paid or €5 on the day of the Show
- 4) ENTRY FEES: The entry fee will be based on the following scale: Entries will be received up to and including 3rd May 2019 postmark and On line midnight the 10th May 2019 (Fees Below)

- 5) **REJECTING ENTRIES etc.:** The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry. Advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue or allocation of stand space at the show.
- 6) INELIGIBLE ENTRIES: if before judging of a class or classes in which his dog is entered, an exhibitor reports that he has entered a dog in a class for which it is not eligible .he may be permitted to transfer his entry to the equivalent class or classes for the correct Breed or sex. No other transfer of an ineligible entry is permitted.
- 7) ENTRY FORMS (mistakes in): The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by exhibitors and while every endeavour will be made to have forms correctly interpreted the promoting body cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes therein.
- 8) As there are no entry fees being charged, there will be no prize money. Special prizes offered for competition by or through a specialist club shall be collected and distributed by that club.
- 9) **VETERINARY EXAMINATION:** The Veterinary Surgeon on call will have the power to exclude any exhibit which in his opinion .is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of Dis-ease,

lice or other cause.

- 10) Judges: In the event of any appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges. If a judge receives an entry over 150 dogs a breed/s may be allocated to another qualified judge.
- 11) JUDGING: Breed, Obedience, Agility and Junior handling Judging will commence at 9.30 a.m. sharp. No claim will be considered in the event of any exhibit being late.
- 12) No person will be allowed in the Judging ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an Exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the judging ring. The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring at the time of judging.
- **13) ALL ANNOUNCEMENTS** appearing in the 'Evening Herald', prior to the date of closing of entries and in reference to any alterations made by the committee in the schedule or in these regulations. Shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
- 14) Interpretation: The Committee of the Swords and District Canine Society shall be the Show Committee within the meaning of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. rules, and all disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any such dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- **15) ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE:** The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
- **16) EXHIBITS:** Each exhibitor shall be responsible to keep their exhibits under proper control at all times. Every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent not later then 6 p.m

Breeds Not Separately Listed (Unlisted Breeds)

Breeds entered in the Breeds Not Separately Listed at National Championship Shows will be entered into their appropriate breed class and the breed listed in the Catalogue.

A Judge may award a Green Star and Best of Breed in each breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible, if in his/her opinion they are of sufficient quality and graded excellent or in the case of puppies "Very Promising".

OBEDIENCE CLASS DEFINITIONS

<u>PRE -BEGINNERS</u> Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded a first prize (on or under 10 marks) in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club.

<u>BEGINNERS</u> Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or awarded three or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks) in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club.

<u>NOVICE</u> Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience class other than in Beginners Obedience class.

<u>CLASS (A) OBEDIENCE (GRADUATE)</u> Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience Class other than in Beginners and Novice Obedience classes.

<u>CLASS (B) OBEDIENCE (LIMIT)</u> Confined to dogs which have not been awarded a Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience Classes with the exception of Beginners, Novice or Graduate Obedience classes.

CLASS (C) CH. OBEDIENCE (OPEN) Open to all.

AGILITY CLASS DEFINITIONS

Grade 1 For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows. *N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class*

Grade 2 For owners, handlers or dogs which have qualified out of Grade 1 but have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. *N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.*

Grade 3 Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 4 Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 5 Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.

Grade 6 Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

Grade 7 Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 6 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows. Two first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

RULES FOR JUDGING

- 1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
- Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
- **3.** No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
- **4.** A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
- 5. Groups will be divided into ten sections as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
- **6.** Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
- 7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
- **8.** Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
- 9. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

Notice for schedule

The Stakes Classes scheduled at this Show are separate from the Breed Judging and do not come under the rules of the Green Star System, e.g. An exhibit which has been beaten in a Stakes Class but wins Best of Breed may proceed to compete in its relevant Group.

All exhibits who wish to enter Stakes Classes must be entered in their relevant Breed Classes with the exception of Champions/Veterans who may enter the Stakes Class only.

A separate judge other than the Best in Show or Group judge must be used for stakes classes (Best in Show qualified)

Procedures will come into effect from the 1st January 2011

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under nine months of age on the day of the Show

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.****

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.)

FIELD TRIAL CLASS is confined to dogs that have won at least a reserve in a Novice, Puppy, Derby or Open Stake.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in **ONE BREED CLASS ONLY** (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

TEAM CLASS is for three or more exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

The Japanese Akita

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds; American Akita and Akita Inu - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/American Akita (not yet assessed)

At all shows where there are entries of unassessed Akitas three of the assessors on the panel drawn up by the Irish Kennel Club will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.

We suggest that they are placed last in the order of judging, as the judge on the day will have to be absent from the ring during the assessment. It is envisaged that the number of unassessed dogs will decrease over the next six months and eventually all Akitas will be designated as American Akita or Akita Inu.

Videos

It is a Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day.


