SHOW REGULATIONS

1. The show will be held under the Licence, Rules & Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club CLG., and rules & regulations of the Border Collie Club of Ireland.
2. The show will be held at Forest Farm, Dublin Road, Athy, Co. Kildare.
3. **ENTRIES CLOSE: Friday 9th August 2019**

Entry Fees – OBEDIENCE: Class OB1 - OB5 ... €5.00 per dog per class,
Class OB6 ... €8.00 per dog.
AGILITY: All classes ... €5.00 per dog per class.

There is a reduction of €3.00 PER EXHIBITOR for all fully paid up members of the Border Collie Club of Ireland.

Cheques / Postal orders to be made payable to The Border Collie Club of Ireland.

CAR PARK FREE. Pre-paid catalogue €2.00 (per day)

Show (gates) opens at 9.00am on Saturday, 8.00am on Sunday.

4. Border Collie Club of Ireland reserve the right to refuse any entry.
 5. Dogs under 4 months of age are not eligible to enter.
 6. All dogs must be registered or transferred with the Irish Kennel Club save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club. Failure to comply with the above will result in (a) the dog being disqualified from the event AND (b) the exhibitor being fined €127 - the implementation of which shall be a normal office routine. All appeals to the Irish Kennel Club should carry a fee of €6 refundable if the appeal is upheld.
 7. All wins prior to the day specified for the closing of entries shall be taken into account when entering any class.
 8. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class.
 9. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show grounds is forbidden.
 10. Judges & Judging:
Obedience Show Saturday 31st August 2019 - Judging will commence at **10.00am.**
Agility Show Sunday 1st September 2019 – Judging will commence at **9.00am.**
- In the event of any judge failing to keep his/her engagement, the committee of Border Collie Club of Ireland shall have the right to appoint another judge. No person will be allowed in the judging ring except the judge, show officials or an exhibitor taking a dog in for adjudication. The exhibit number for each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler. Border Collie Club of Ireland shall not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring.
11. Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping their dog under proper control at all times.
 12. The catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms and while every effort will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted, the committee cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes, which bring the exhibitor within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club CLG., Rule 15, section 1, or for clerical errors that may occur during compilation.
 13. Exhibitors must clean up if their dog fouls the grounds, suitable facilities will be provided. Any exhibitor failing to clean up after their dog will be liable to a €25 fine.
 14. Border Collie Club of Ireland will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
 15. Ring numbers will be distributed at the show.

Obedience Class Definitions

Pre Beginners Obedience is confined to dogs and handlers which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any Obedience test or (b) **three** or more First prizes in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club Rules or (c) under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club.

Beginners Obedience is confined to dogs and handlers which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any Obedience test or (b) **four** or more First prizes in any obedience test, except Pre Beginners, under Irish Kennel Club Rules or (c) under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club.

Novice Obedience is confined to dogs which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test or (b) four or more First prizes in any obedience test except Pre Beginners and/or Beginners.

Class A Obedience is confined to dogs which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test or (b) four or more First prizes in any obedience test except Beginners and/or Novice.

Class B Obedience is confined to dogs which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test or (b) four First prizes in any obedience test except Beginners and/or Novice and/or Class A.

Ch. Class C Obedience is open to all.

Agility Class Definitions

Grade 1 - For handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Irish Kennel Club CLG., licensed Agility Shows or any Kennel Club recognised by the Irish Kennel Club CLG. *N.B. Handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.*

Grade 2 - For handlers or dogs which have qualified out of Grade 1 but have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Irish Kennel Club CLG., licensed Agility Shows or any Kennel Club recognised by the Irish Kennel Club CLG., or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. *N.B. Handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.*

Grade 3 - Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Irish Kennel Club CLG., licensed Agility Shows or any Kennel Club recognised by the Irish Kennel Club CLG., and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 4 - Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Irish Kennel Club CLG., licensed Agility Shows or any Kennel Club recognised by the Irish Kennel Club CLG., and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 5 - Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Irish Kennel Club CLG., licensed Agility Shows or any Kennel Club recognised by the Irish Kennel Club CLG., and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.

Grade 6 - Open to dogs which have gained three first places in a Class (1 Agility) at Grade 5 at Irish Kennel Club CLG., licensed Agility Shows or any Kennel Club recognised by the Irish Kennel Club CLG., and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

Grade 7 - Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 6 at Irish Kennel Club CLG., licensed Agility Shows only. Two first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.
